1	<p><b>Jammu – Katra</b></p> <p>On the arrival at Katra our representative will be there to greet you and take you to the pre-booked hotel. After Arrival at Jammu our Randhe Holidays representative will meet you and then take a transfer to Katra (50 kms - 1.5 hrs.). Check into the hotel in the late evening and take a rest. 2	<p><b>Darshan Day</b></p> <p>Early morning take a transfer to Vaishnodevi Darshan, Please note: (Total 13 kms walk to the temple that takes about 4-5 hours). Enroute stops at Ardhkuwari Temple and darshan at Baba Bhairavnath Temple is recommended). During Summer and peak travel season it may be advisable to start the climb previous evening. Once queue tickets are purchased the wait period could be half an hour to 3 hours depending on the rush. During season Yatra Parchi (entry tickets required to beginning the uphill walk), it is recommended to purchase in advance to avoid delays. Guests looking for Heli Darshan (Helicopter ride, darshan and back), morning flights are recommended for best weather and least uncertainty. 3	<p><b>Katra – Pahalgam</b></p> <p>After a delectable breakfast, check-out from the hotel and drive to Pahalgam. Also known as the village of shepherds, Pahalgam attracts hordes of tourists owing to its gradually dropping temperature and the glistening river, Lidder flowing through here. Also, one of the best health resorts in the country, this astounding site is famous for its vast meadows, pine forests, pastures and favorable weather. 4	<p><b>Pahalgam Sightseeing</b></p> <p>After Breakfast proceed to the sightseeing in Pahalgam.</p> <p><b>ARU VALLEY:</b> - It is located around 12 km from Pahalgam, 11 km upstream from the Lidder River. Noted for its scenic meadows, lakes and mountains, it is a base camp for trekking to the Kolahoi Glacier and Tarsar Lake. The village lies on the left bank of the Aru river, which is a tributary of the Lidder river The Aru valley is noted for its scenic meadows. It is popular among the tourists for its peaceful environment and scenic beauty. Other popular tourist activities include fishing for trout in the Lidder river, trekking, hiking, horse riding, sightseeing and photography.</p> <p><b>BETAAB VALLEY:</b> - Situated at a distance of 15 kilometers from Pahalgam. The valley got its name from the Sunny Deol– Amrita Singh hit debut film Betaab. The valley is surrounded by lush green meadows, snow clad mountains and covered with dense vegetation. 	<p>Valley is a very popular tourist destination. Betaab Valley is also a favorite campsite of travelers as it also serves as a base camp for trekking and further exploration of the mountains. The valley is a walk-able distance from Pahalgam. The crystal clear &amp; chilly water of the stream bubbling down from the snowy hills is a delight; locals here drink this water too. Baisaran and Tulian Lake are few nearby attractions that can be visited.</p> <p><b>CHANDANWARI:</b> - Situated 16 km from Pahalgam, is the starting point of the Amaranth Yatra, which takes place every year in the month of Sawan (Rain). It is famous for snow sledding on a snow bridge. Taxi cabs can be hired from Pahalgam for a round-trip. Snow fights" is what people generally indulge in here before they sledge back down. Many prefer to sip a cup of tea or snack at the nearby dhabas. Hajan, on the way to Chandanwari is an idyllic spot for a picnic. Via Tangmarg Road, and after covering around 50 km, arrive at your destination. Post reaching here, transfer to the hotel and relax for some time.
